## TAI Club News & Information

### **New Members** - Marty Adams & Carl Tate **Mower Maintenance & Repair**

On a rainy Saturday May 4<sup>th</sup>, some club members met at the shed to do the annual maintenance on our Bobcat mower. There had been an issue with the right hydraulic pulley. Investigating deeper, the pulley feel off was wollered out, the pump shaft scored and keys sheared off in both. All needed replacing to get the mover rolling again. Just by chance 6 of the members present were club officers so we called an on-the-spot emergency meeting and agreed this repair of removing the hydraulic unit was more than we were able to do. I called Forsyth Mower and they were able to schedule a pickup on Wednesday with a roughly 2 week turn-a-round. The estimate was about \$1000.00. This was much better than expected and scheduled the pickup on Wednesday. The officers approved an emergency funding of \$2500.00 to fix the Bobcat which we have also requested a muffler replacement, new hydraulic oil & filters and adjustments. We went ahead and did our annual maintenance (new oil, filters & blades) on the mower. The weather looks like rain off & on next week, but if someone wants to bring their mower down to mow next Saturday 11<sup>th</sup> and possibly 18<sup>th</sup>, the club will supply the gas. Also, we will be scheduling grass seeding and fertilizing soon.

### **The Heart Beat of Our RC Club**

There was an article in this month's Aviation Magazine where the writer had a heart attack at their field, the EMT's couldn't find the field which cost precious minutes but there were members that performed CPR, he was shocked 4 time after EMT's arrived to get a heart rhythm. The member's knowing CPR is what saved his life! I have spoken to David Holt (Safety Coordinator) and most of the directors, and David is going to investigate if we can get an EMT group or some medical related group in the county to offer us free CPR training to all our club members. I know at one time I was certified but that has been years ago and I'm sure the CPR techniques have changed since then. Maybe you need a refresher course in CPR. too We would like to have the training at the field but we may have to go to a location where their equipment is (who ever they may be?). We will let you know more details on this in the near future but I would encourage all our members to learn and get certified in CPR. Not just for the club but for your families and friends as well.
