### **Watch Those Props – Like Getting Hit with a Foul Ball**

I'm not mentioning any names, but a little birdy (its was actually a flock) told me that a member was standing in front of an energized electric plane (strike 1), had the transmitter laying on the ground (ball 1) without the throttle lock on (strike 2) and when they reached to pick up the transmitter hit the throttle stick by accident (strike 3 – you're out) and whammo!! I hear there was no major cuts, but a badly bruised leg and a broken prop. And those famous words, "well, I want do that s#!t again". As a reminder, accidents happen very fast and most can be prevented. Please, take that extra 15 seconds, always stand behind the prop, check to see your transmitter is on and the throttle lock set before plugging in the battery.

### **The Heart Beat of Our RC Club Gets Stronger**

David Holt has investigated and got pricing on CPR training. We are confirming pricing but first information is \$375 for basic training [approx. 2 hours] of 15 people (\$25 per person) or \$550 if we prefer to get CPR Certified training [approx. 4 hours] for 15 people (\$36.67 per person). We will need to get a count of how many members would be interested. The proposal is the club to cover the cost of members training for either basic or certification in CPR. If there are immediate family of club members that would like the training also, it will be up to the family member to cover their cost for either training. If we have enough people wanting this, they can do the training at the field.
